***Pond 1 Cincy Pond Guy's Pond**

11011 Sand Run Road

Harrison OH 45030

Dan Meyer is the owner of Meyer Aquascapes. Arrive at the top of the driveway and you will see a 60' x 30', 14,000 gallon water garden with an island in the center connected with a stone bridge. There are three waterfalls, two fish tunnels around the island and many water lilies. Staff from Meyer Aquascapes and literature will be at this location.

Directions: Take **I-275** to Kilby Rd Exit, **right** at exit, **right** on Suspension Bridge Rd, **right** on Lawrenceburg Rd, and **left** on Sand Run Rd to 11011 on the left. Follow **private drive to top of hill**.

***Pond 2 Greg and Rose Altenau**

16 Turnberry

North Bend OH 45052

New this year! You get three features at one stop! The Pondless waterfall in the front was installed in the Spring of 2008. Recently re-landscaped, the 10 foot stream is surrounded by weathered limestone rock creating a dramatic entrance to this Aston Oaks home. Descending the natural Aston rock steps will lead to two secluded water features set in the woods above the 15th hole of the Jack Nicholas designed Golf Course at Aston Oaks. At the bottom of the steps is a large pond designed with natural rock found on the property, plenty of natural plants and stocked with large goldfish. This is a tranquil spot for relaxation and reflection. Follow the gravel trail to the newest water feature, a 40 foot waterbed creek with a recycling Pondless feature. This beautiful wooded stream has 7 cascading falls. Relax on the 6 x 8 flagstone patio at the bottom of the stream and soak in the nature in this secluded wooded haven. All three of the water features are dramatically lit at night.

Directions: From pond 1 to pond 2 travel 6.31 miles. Turn **right** out of driveway onto Sand Run Rd, turn **right** onto Lawrenceburg Rd, **left** onto Suspension Bridge Rd, **right** onto Kilby Rd, **left** onto US-50 and travel 3 miles, turn **left** onto St. Annes Drive, **right** onto Turnberry Dr, go to 16 Turnberry Dr.

Pond 3 Aston Oaks Golf Clubhouse

One Aston Oaks Drive

North Bend OH 45052

This large Pondless feature is located behind the clubhouse for viewing by the patrons in the restaurant, wedding parties, and golfers. This is a 20 feet wide by 20 feet high feature built out of natural stone from the area with 16 waterfalls. It's impressive and has a great sound. This is a great stop for lunch or dinner at the Oak Leaf Restaurant.

Directions: From pond 2 to pond 3 travel 1.09 miles. Turn **left** out of driveway onto Turnberry Dr, turn **left** onto Abby Hill Ln, **left** onto St. Andrews Dr, **left** onto Muirfield Dr, **right** onto Stratford, **right** onto Aston Oaks Dr and continue until you see the Golf Clubhouse. Parking is available in the general parking lot and walk along the **right side** of the Clubhouse to the water feature. This feature is not available for night viewing due to a wedding on Saturday night.

Pond 4 Susan Hensley

1346 Castlebridge Ct

Cincinnati OH 45233

Beautiful heart shaped 14 x 16 pond where the waterfall flows over a built in stone wall. Shade gardens surround the waterfall and wall for a pleasing backdrop to the pond.

Directions: From pond 3 to pond 4 travel 5.40 miles. Return to Shady Ln and turn **right**, turn **left** onto US-50 at the light, to **left** on Dining Ln, **right** on Main St which becomes Hillside Ave, continue on Hillside Ave which turns into Cleves Warsaw Pike and travel up the hill for 1.7 miles, turn **left** on Wexford Ln and **left** onto **Castlebridge to the carriage homes, 1346 Castlebridge Ct**.

Pond 5 Terri Kluesener and Julie Fatora

6000 Cleves Warsaw Pike

Cincinnati OH 45233

This smaller pond is a perfect example of how a pond, regardless of its size, can bring peace and serenity into a backyard. Come sit on the patio and let the sound of the cascading water slowly ease away the daily stress. Take off your shoes and let the Koi nibble on your toes. The pond is approximately 11'x 6', has a two foot waterfall and is nestled close to the patio, deck and hot tub.

Directions: From pond 4 to pond 5 travel about 1 mile. From Castlebridge turn **right** on Wexford and **left** onto Cleves Warsaw Pike, go through the light at Ebenezer and to a **private drive on the left** at 6000 Cleves Warsaw Pike.

***Pond 6 Marathon Station (6094 Bridgetown Rd)**

Corner of Ebenezer and Bridgetown Roads

Cincinnati OH 45248

This is a large Pondless waterfall with three powerful waterfalls. Two of the waterfalls face the street and one faces the gas station. The front waterfalls push 15,000 gallons per hour. The feature is constructed with Weathered Limestone rock.

Directions: From pond 5 to pond 6 travel 3 miles. Turn **right out of drive** onto Cleves Warsaw, turn **right** onto Ebenezer Rd. when you come to the **hair pin curve**, turn **right** to cross the bridge and straight up hill continuing on Ebenezer, **continue through the light at Werk and Ebenezer**, at 3rd light you will see the water feature from this location, turn into the **Marathon Station** located at intersection of Ebenezer and Bridgetown.

Pond 7 Bill Bross and Susan Auel

2232 South Road

Cincinnati OH 45233

This well established 11 x 16 pond has a 20 foot stream and two waterfalls. Location is very serene. Yard is beautifully landscaped with a mix of annual colors, native gardens and bird feeding areas.

Directions: From pond 6 to pond 7 travel 2.87 miles. Going **west** on Bridgetown Rd, travel for 1.1 miles, **at second traffic light turn left** onto South Rd, bear **right** to stay on South Rd, **end at 2232 South Rd.**

Pond 8 Russ and Donna Welty

8183 Jordan Road

Cleves OH 45002

This spectacular 28 x 65 pond gives a magnificent view from all rooms facing the pond, decks and patios. Pond has 70 tons of boulders and 30,000 gallons of water. There are two large waterfalls separated by a 15 foot stone bridge. Lots of Koi with a fish cave and the landscaping is beautiful. Every year new wonders are added and this feature gets better every year.

Directions: From pond 7 to pond 8 travel 5.75 miles. Turn **right** out of driveway onto South Rd, turn **left at stop sign** to stay on South Rd, **at the traffic light turn left** onto Bridgetown Rd for 2.8 miles, turn **right** onto Zion Rd, **slight left** onto Jordan Rd, to 8183 Jordan Rd.

THIS ENDS THE WEST SIDE TOUR

To return to expressway turn **right out of driveway onto Jordan Road**, continue straight on Zion Rd to Bridgetown Rd, turn **left** on Bridgetown Rd, **left** at traffic light onto Dog Trot, **right** onto Taylor Rd, **left** on Rybolt Rd, and a **left** takes you to **Harrison Ave.** Here you can continue on the tour and take **I-74 West to merge with I-275** OR you can go **East onto I-74.**

NORTH CENTRAL TOUR (41 miles)

Pond 9 Bert and Carol Cannon

5643 Krystal Court

Cincinnati OH 45252

This secluded wooded setting has everything with an 8 x 11 pond near the house and the pool. A Pondless waterfall with a 35 foot stream and several waterfalls are built in the wooded setting. Stroll across the wooden bridge to get a great view of the stream. A true backyard retreat!

Directions: From pond 8 to pond 9 travel 14 miles. (Note: Wesselman Rd is closed between Rybolt Rd and Harrison Ave. to thru traffic due to construction)

From Jordan Rd take a **right** out of driveway, continue on Zion Rd to Bridgetown Rd, take a **left** on Bridgetown and a **left** on Dog Trout, take a **right** on Taylor Rd and a **left** on Rybolt Rd, and this takes you to **Harrison Ave.** Turn **left** onto Harrison Ave, merge onto **I-74 West** and a few miles down merge **to the right onto I-275 North toward I-75 for 5.2 miles, take Exit 33** onto Colerain Ave (US 27) and turn left, take another **left** on Old Colerain Ave, a **slight left** onto Day Road, **right** onto Gosling Rd, **right** onto Kristiridge Dr, and **right** on to Krystal Ct. Home in the Cul-de-sac at end of Krystal Ct.

Pond 10 Martin Gleason

5269 Stonetrace Drive

Cincinnati OH 45251

Follow the brick pathway to a beautiful 11 x 16 pond with a 10 foot stream and two waterfalls. Built of sandstone and viewed from a deck that cantilevers over the pond or from the patio.

Directions: From pond 9 to pond 10 travel 5.6 miles. From Krystal Ct, turn **left** onto Kristiridge Dr, **left** onto Gosling Rd, **left** onto Day Rd, **slight right** onto Old Colerain Ave, **left onto US-27**, go 2.1 miles **to right** onto W Kemper Rd, immediate **left onto Stone Mill Rd, right** onto Stonetrace Dr, **left** at the **stop sign** to 5269 Stonetrace Dr.

Pond 11 Bonita and Gene Brockert**2382 Crest Road****Cincinnati OH 45231**

A 20 x 20 large Sandstone water feature which is framed with lush landscaping, gazebo and a pergola. Walk throughout the property to enjoy the variety of spectacular gardens, statues and rock fountain. Sit on the benches and watch the dragonflies and see the beautiful Koi swimming in the pond and pause a moment to just enjoy.

Directions: From pond 10 to pond 11 travel 4.6 miles. From driveway, go **west** on Stonetrace Dr, turn **left** onto Stone Mill Rd, **left** onto W Kemper Rd and travel for 2.5 miles, **right** onto Pippin Rd, **left** onto Crest Rd, to 2382 Crest Rd.

Pond 12 Tim and Chris Jones**2510 Crest Road****Cincinnati OH 45231**

This 15 x 15 pond shows how a larger feature can work in a small suburban setting. Large boulders give a natural appearance and the large flat rocks are perfect for sitting. This back yard transitions from family play area to backyard paradise.

Directions: From pond 11 travel a short block to pond 12. Continue on Crest Rd and 2510 is on the right.

Pond 13 Dave and Marilyn Schofield*1558 Covered Bridge Road****Cincinnati OH 45231**

Enjoy this 12 x 22 water garden featuring a unique large waterfall and created with sandstone. The pond is surrounded by a deck for viewing and entertaining. The plantings in the water feature add color to the beautiful backyard paradise.

Directions: From pond 12 to pond 13 travel 3.65 miles. From Crest Rd, turn **right** onto Hamilton Avenue and travel for 3.2 miles, turn **left** onto Miles Rd, a **slight right** continues Miles Road, **right** onto Covered Bridge Rd, 1558 Covered Bridge Rd is on the left side.

Pond 14 Nick and Margaret Ursini**7252 Saint Ives Place****West Chester OH 45069**

New this year! Enjoy this breathtaking pondless water feature with over 40 tons of weathered limestone used to create the water feature and retaining walls. This feature has two streams, on the left side is a 30 foot stream tucked away into the hillside with 3 waterfalls and the other on the right with a 20 foot stream and waterfalls. The streams come together and drop into a 6 x 6 pooling area and together they travel into the Pondless basin. At the end of the basin in a dry creek bed that continues into a natural creek bed behind the property. The water feature is complemented by 2 stone bridges connecting to stone pathways that guide you around this backyard paradise. Naturally curving paver patios with build-in seating walls and a fire pit make for the perfect entertaining area for family and friends. The stunning landscape is surrounded by native plantings and perennials for an added touch of color. Climb the natural stone steps up towards the house where you will find another paver patio and large deck which offers a wonderful view of the entire backyard. The private wooded setting makes you forget you are in a subdivision!

Directions: From pond 13 to pond 14 travel 18.6 miles. Go **northwest** on Covered Bridge Rd toward Miles Rd, turn **left** onto Miles Rd, turn **right** onto Hamilton Ave/US-127 for 2.5 miles, **merge onto I-275 E** toward I-75/Dayton and travel for 7.1 miles, **merge onto I-75 N** via Exit 43B toward Dayton and travel for approximately 5 miles, take **Exit 22** (Tylersville Road), turn **left** onto Tylersville Rd, turn **right** onto Wetherington Rd (entering Wetherington Golf Community), **left** onto St. Ives Pl, **end at 7252 Saint Ives Pl.**

Pond 15 Gene and Karin Dyke**5571 Kyles Lane****Liberty Township OH 45044**

This front yard location in a private setting has 6 waterfalls. Near the home entrance, begin with a waterfall that cascades down to a stream flowing under the walkway to a waterfall that drops into the pond. Two additional waterfalls are on the opposite side of the pond. The sixth waterfall falls from the pond into a vanishing edge basin. 70 tons of Weathered Limestone boulders give this a beautiful natural setting.

Directions: From pond 14 to pond 15 travel 4.73 miles. From Saint Ives Pl, turn **right** onto Wetherington Rd, **right** onto Tylersville Rd, **right** onto Cincinnati-Dayton Rd and stay right on Cincinnati-Dayton Rd for approximately 3 miles, turn **right** onto Kyles Station Rd, **right** onto Kyles Ln, **follow private drive and bear left to drive marked 5571, pond is at the end of the driveway.**

Pond 16 Brad and Sylvia Franks**5467 Charleston Woods Drive****Middletown OH 45044**

This pond has double waterfalls with a 12 foot stream falling again to a 33 x 16 pond. The feature was constructed using large sandstone boulders and pumps over 9,000 GPH. Lots of colorful fish, and landscaped with many colorful flowers, grasses and shrubs.

Directions from pond 15 to pond 16 travel 2.47 miles. From Kyles Ln, turn **left** onto Kyles Station Rd and travel for 2 miles, turn **left** onto Charleston Woods Dr, to 5467.

Pond 17 Jeff and Shirley Konen**7085 Linn Road****Liberty Township OH 45044**

This established 14 x 16 pond is built with Weathered Limestone boulders. This perfect sized pond is situated next to the paver patio and can be viewed from the inside rooms of the home.

Directions: From pond 16 to pond 17 travel 1.19 miles. From driveway, turn **left** onto Charleston Woods Dr toward Kyles Station Rd, turn **right** onto Kyles Station Rd, **left** onto Yankee Rd, **right** onto Linn Rd, end at 7085 Linn Rd.

THIS ENDS THE NORTH CENTRAL TOUR**EAST SIDE TOUR (70 Miles)****Pond 18 David Hyde and Candy Hart****3011 Cooperhill Drive****Evendale OH 45241**

This is an outstanding example of a Pondless stream, perfect for a heavily shaded garden. This Pondless features 10 waterfalls, an island, an “invisible” bridge, and a hollow log passage into a 55 foot stream. Water feature is surrounded by a magnificent landscape of Hosta and Impatiens.

Directions: From pond 17 to pond 18 travel 18 miles. From Linn Rd go east toward Linn Ln, **turn right** onto Cincinnati-Dayton Rd and travel for 3.5 miles, **merge** onto Butler County Veterans Hwy/OH-129 E via the ramp on the left toward I-75/Dayton/Cincinnati, **merge** onto I-75 S via Exit 25A toward Cincinnati for 9.9 miles, take Exit 14 (Glendale Milford Rd) toward Woodlawn/Evendale, take the ramp toward Evendale, **merge** onto Glendale Milford Rd, turn **right** onto Reading Rd, **left** onto Cooper Rd, **left** onto Winnebago Trail and **left immediately onto Cooperhill Dr. House is located at the end of cul-de-sac on the left.**

Pond 19 Ron and Patti Grycko**3660 Vineyard Ridge****Blue Ash OH 45242**

New this year! A complete back yard make over. This location had a very steep sloping hill which now has a 40 foot long stream with large Sandstone boulders which goes into a basin at the bottom of hill. Take the stone steps down the hill along the stream to a paver patio and a sitting wall. The upper area near the house has an outdoor living space perfect for relaxing and entertaining.

Directions: From pond 18 to pond 19 travel 2.7 miles. From Cooperhill Dr, turn **right** onto Winnebago Trail, **right** onto Cooper Rd, **right** onto Reading Rd, **right** onto Glendale Milford Rd, **right** onto Giverny Blvd, turn **right** onto Vineyard Ridge, to 3660 Vineyard Ridge.

Pond 20 Richard and Jane Morgan**2606 Maple Tree Court****Reading OH 45236**

10 x 12 pond with a 25 foot stream, bending twice around the screened porch and into a well established pond. Shaded area is very relaxing. Yard is certified as a “Backyard Wildlife Habitat” by the National Wildlife Federation.

Directions: From pond 19 to pond 20 travel 3.4 miles. From Vineyard Ridge, turn **right** onto Giverny Blvd, **left** onto Carpenters Creek Dr, **right** onto Fawnrun Dr, **left** onto Gateclub Dr, **right** onto Carpenters Run, **left** onto Cooper Rd, **right** onto Reed Hartman Highway which becomes Plainfield Rd, turn **right** onto Hunt Rd, **left** onto Waxwing Dr and **right** onto Maple Tree Court, end at 2606 Maple Tree Court.

Pond 21 Greg and Kathleen Bell**7033 Beech Hollow Drive****Amberley OH 45236**

There are three different levels built with Weathered Limestone boulders. There is a 25 foot stream with a small top pond traveling down to a 15 foot stream into a 5,000 gallon pond. Koi and Shubunkin fish are in the pond surrounded by beautiful landscaping and boulders. These streams and landscape boulders can be viewed from various locations around the yard where sitting areas have been strategically placed for relaxing and enjoying the pond.

Directions: From pond 20 to pond 21 travel 4.4 miles. From Maple Tree Court, turn **left** onto Waxwing Dr, **right** onto Hunt Rd, **merge** onto Ronald Regan Cross County Highway/OH-126 W and travel for 1.5 miles, take the Ridge Rd Exit, **left** onto Ridge Rd, **left** onto E. Galbraith Rd, turn **right** onto Rollman Estates Dr and **left** onto Beech Hollow Dr, to 7033 Beech Hollow Drive.

Pond 22 Jason and Jill Pyles**10721 Weatherstone Court****Loveland OH 45140**

New this year! This is a very private wooded setting which the backyard was transformed from a wooded 40 x 20 area to a very beautiful quaint outdoor space. Follow the natural stone steps from the four season room around the 8 x 10 pond with a 12 foot stream and three waterfalls to the deck or take the natural stone steps to the paver patio. The sound of the water can be heard from the deck, patio, the four season room and the master bedroom.

Directions: From pond 21 to pond 22 travel 13 miles. From Beech Hollow Drive, turn **right** onto Rollman Estates Dr, **left** onto E. Galbraith Rd, **right** onto Ridge Rd, **merge** onto Ronald Regan Cross County Highway/OH-126 E and travel for 3.4 miles, **merge** onto I-71 N toward Columbus for 3.3 miles, **merge** onto I-275 E via Exit 17 toward OH-32 for another 1 mile, take **Exit 50** (US-22/OH-3) toward Morrow, a **slight right** onto Montgomery Rd, **right** onto E. Kemper Rd, turn **right** onto Weatherstone Ct, end at 10721 Weatherstone Court.

Pond 23 Jeff and Patricia Wuennemann**7120 Misty Meadow Lane****Morrow OH 45152**

This is a beautiful 24 x 20 pond built with large boulders and a large waterfall. The paver patio is located between the pond and the house where this lovely outdoor living area has been created. There is an outdoor fire pit, stone bar and grill, a cedar Pergola area along with the designed landscaped areas surround this living space.

Directions: From pond 22 to pond 23 travel 16.4 miles. From Weatherstone Court, turn **left** onto E. Kemper Rd, turn left to stay on E Kemper Rd for 1.3 miles, turn **right** onto Montgomery Road/US-22/OH-3 and continue to follow US-22/OH-3 for 12.2 miles, turn **right** onto Houston Ave, **left** onto Highlawn Ave, **right** onto Welch Rd/Township Rd 167, **right** onto Morrow-Rossburg Rd/CR-27, turn **left** onto Morrow Meadow Dr and **left** onto Misty Meadow Ln. 7120 Misty Meadow Lane is on the right.

Pond 24 Luke and Andrea Holman**SATURDAY ONLY!!!****777 Regent Road****Cincinnati OH 45241**

Back on the tour this year! This lovely 22 x 18 pond tucked in close to the patio to create a beautiful and relaxing environment. It has a large waterfall and fish tunnel for the Koi and goldfish. Pond has mature plants which display well in this beautiful entertaining area.

Directions: From pond 23 to pond 24 travel 25.44 miles. From Misty Meadow Lane, turn **right** onto Morrow Meadow Dr, turn **left** onto Morrow-Rossburg Rd/CR-27 for .4 miles, **left** onto Morrow-Rossburg Rd/CR-27 and follow CR-27 for 1.6 miles, **right** onto Morrow-Rossburg Rd/CR-27 for 1.5 miles, turn **right** onto OH-132 and travel for 4.3 miles, turn **right** onto OH-132/OH-28 and follow OH-28 for 6.1 miles, OH-28 becomes OH-28-BYP/OH-28 and travel for 1.3 miles, OH-28 BYP/OH-28 becomes OH-28 and travel for .4 miles, **merge** onto I-275 S via the ramp on the left toward OH-32/Kentucky and travel for 8.2 miles, take **Exit 65** (OH-125/Beechmont Ave) toward Amelia, turn **right** onto OH-125/Beechmont Ave/Ohio Pike, turn **right** onto Mt. Carmel Tobasco Rd, **right** onto Regent Rd, go to 777 Regent Road.

Pond 25 Sean and Denise Mullarkey**1703 Kingsway Court****Cincinnati OH 45230**

Member of Greater Cincinnati Water Garden Society

A kidney shaped pond 20 x 16 with a 4 foot wide waterfall. There is a feeding rock where Shubunkin fish come to be fed. The pond is surrounded with landscaping that gives the pond a natural and pleasing look. A natural oasis.

Ask about membership to the Water Garden Society.

Directions: From pond 24 to pond 25 travel 5 miles. From Regent Road, turn **left** onto Mt. Carmel Tobasco Rd, **right** onto OH-125/Beechmont Ave/Ohio Pike and follow for 3 miles, turn **right** onto Paddison Rd, **right** onto Robinway Dr, turn **right** onto Kingsway Court, end at 1703 Kingsway Court.

To end the tour here: from Kingsway Court, right on Robinway Dr, right on Gammwell Dr, left on Wittmeyer Dr, right onto State Rd, right onto Five Mile Rd. This will take you to I-275 North or South to Kentucky to I-471.

To continue with the Kentucky Tour: Take I-275 South and merge onto I-471 South, take Exit 74B (Newport/Cincinnati), See below for directions to Pond 27.

KENTUCKY TOUR (39 Miles)

25 West Villa Place

Ft. Thomas KY 41075

This is a well maintained small backyard that has been beautifully transformed into a backyard paradise. This lovely 11 x 16 Weathered Limestone Pond has a 25 foot stream with two waterfalls with an added touch of beautiful driftwood. Water feature has complimented this lovely back yard. Pavers are used to surround this area which opens up this area to several entertainment areas. Home is one of the older original homes in the Fort Thomas area.

Directions: From pond 25 to pond 26 travel 12.3 miles. From Kingsway, **right** on Robinway Dr, **right** on Gammwell Dr, **left** on Wittmeyer Dr, **right** onto State Rd, **right** onto Five Mile Rd. This will take you to **I-275 S to Kentucky**. Merge onto I-275 W to Kentucky, crossing into KY, travel 6 miles to the **I-471 merge toward Newport**. Take the **Newport/Ft Thomas Exit (Grand Ave)**, go towards Fort Thomas, **follow Grand Ave up the hill**, at the **first stop sign** where **Grand Ave changes to S Fort Thomas Ave** and the road goes to two lanes, turn **left at this stop sign** onto **S Fort Thomas Ave**, turn **right** to stay on S Fort Thomas Ave/KY-1120, turn **left** onto S Fort Thomas Ave/KY-1120W, **turn left onto W Villa Pl, end at 25 W Villa Pl.**

Pond 27 Winston and Susie Faircloth

3552 Blangey Road

Cold Spring, KY 41076

A wooded hillside paradise! A beautiful large 21x16 Koi water garden with two streams, one of which is a 35 foot meandering stream and the other one is a 10 foot stream. Built into the hillside where a beautiful perennial garden meanders in and out of the hillside along with large bounders and waterfalls. This location has several lush hummingbird and butterfly gardens. This home has a great patio for entertaining and the views from inside the house are spectacular.

Check out the Add-A-Sphere for your fish which is available at this location. See ad below.

Directions: From pond 26 to pond 27 travel 2.1 miles. From West Villa Pl, go back to **Fort Thomas Ave/KY-1120 E**, turn **right** onto S Fort Thomas Ave/KY-1120 E, turn **right** onto S. New this year! This is a very private setting where their back yard disappears into a large wooded area. There is a natural stone walk way that begins at the house back patio and leads down the hill then splits off each way to two large bridges that cross the streams then lead to stone steps that take you to the larger paver patio featuring a built in fire pit and seat wall. This large Pondless begins with two streams about 30 feet each dropping down from the house across the sloping hill and crossing under stone walkways and stone bridges where the two streams join as one and drop to a basin at the bottom. This is where the paver for entertaining is located. This is a great feature that is very interactive and creates a center piece for an area that was formerly unusable space. This feature was installed last summer and the entire area is landscaped with natural plants and evergreen trees.

Directions: From pond 27 to pond 28 travel 11.90 miles. From Blangey Rd go back toward KY-8, turn **right** onto KY-8, turn **right** onto Industrial Road/KU-1998 and travel for 2.2 miles, turn **left** onto Alexandria Pike/US-27 and continue to follow US-27 S for approximately 8 miles until where the four lanes end, approximately 200 feet, turn **right** onto South Licking Pike, travel 100 feet take an **immediate left** turn (road ends), the driveway is on the **right** and the house is at the top of the hill, 11410 South Licking Pike.

Go **northwest** on South Licking Pike/KY-10/KY-915 for 1.5 miles, turn **left** onto Creektrace Rd/KY-536 and continue to follow KY-536 for 2.8 miles, turn **right** onto Decoursey Pike/KY-177 for 6.4 miles, **left** onto Wolf Rd, **right** onto Taylor Mill Rd/KY-16, **left** onto Sunset Dr, **right** onto Mill Valley Dr, **left** onto Stone Hill Dr and **left** onto Crocus Ln, end at **795 Crocus Lane on the left.**

This backyard paradise has spectacular ponds and landscaping. Walk thru the arches and down the paved walk to the back. Walk up the stone steps to the 20 x 15 bog garden where the water feature begins. (A bog is the best system to filter large ponds). The paths and stone bridges cross over a 100 foot stream with 6 waterfalls until the stream drops 6 feet into the 30 x 40 pond. Pond holds 20,000 gallons, 150 tons of boulders.

Directions: From pond 30 to pond 31 travel 7.9 miles. From Madison Ave, go south on Madison Ave/KY-17 toward Howard Litzler Rd/KY-3070 and continue to follow KY-17 S, **merge onto I-275 W** and travel for 5.5 miles, take **Exit 2** (Mineola Pike), turn **left** onto Mineola Pike, **left** onto Olympic Blvd E, **right** onto Booneland Trail. Pond is at the **last house on the right**, 3348 Booneland Trail.

To return to I-275, turn **left** out of Booneland Trail, **left** on Olympic Blvd E, **right** on Mineola **which leads to I-275 East or West.**
